

The design architects envisioned a chandelier that would use external light sources directed at the prisms. Our firm experimented with both molten cast glass and water clear acrylic, the architect chose the acrylic for its fine refractive qualities. Each of the 250 prisms measuring 18" long and 3" wide are precisely fabricated to fit the stainless steel spine.
